

The Greatness Of God

Psalms 104:31-35 - The glory of the Lord shall endure for ever: the Lord shall rejoice in his works. He looketh on the earth, and it trembleth: he toucheth the hills, and they smoke. I will sing unto the Lord as long as I live: I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the Lord. Let the sinners be consumed out of the earth, and let the wicked be no more. Bless thou the Lord, O my soul. Praise ye the Lord.

As one meditates upon this Psalm, it sings of the greatness of God. When we read **Psalms 104**, the greatness of God is clearly seen. By greatness, we are talking about the abundance, bigness, bulk, enormity, force, high degree, hugeness, immensity, infinity, intensity, length, magnitude, mass, might, potency, power, sizableness, strength, & vastness of the Lord God Almighty. Therefore:

God's Greatness Is Seen In His Glory (Psalms 104:1-2)

God is honored in the heavens. He is respected in the elements. All of these things depict His majesty. The beasts of the field & the birds of the air honor Him. By nature, these soulless creatures obey His laws. Humanity, as free moral agents, have been given the power of choice by God. We can disobey God, if we want to. We can reject God's love, if we want to. We can turn a deaf ear to the call of God, if we want to. Nevertheless, in the end, we MUST & we WILL give glory to God & acknowledge Jesus is the Christ. Listen to your Bible! In **Philippians 2:11**, the Bible reads, "**And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.**" Unfortunately, this confession, at this point, does not bring salvation to our souls because this glory would have come all too late.

God's Greatness Is Seen In His Power (Psalms 104:3-9)

The wind is God's messenger. The fire is God's servant. The clouds are God's chariot. The mighty waters flee at God's command. His power created & controls the entire universe. In His power, God gives life, protects life, & preserves life...both physically & spiritually, & heals our afflictions. Through God's power, we shall become victors over death, hell, & the grave.

God's Greatness Is Seen In His Grace (Psalms 104:10-25)

Here we see the goodness of God. God supplies water & nourishment for man, beast, creeping thing, & the fowls of the air. By the grace of God, He provides shelter & protection for the weak. Think of small animals & birds for a moment. They are so colored as to hide in the foliage. God has provided what we call natural resources. As a result thereof, we have what we need when we need it. As humanity makes profitable progress, God uncovers the elements to further the progress.

God's Greatness Is Seen In The Heritage Of Man (Psalms 104:26-30)

If God provides so well for the birds of the air & the beasts of the field, then how much more will He provide for man, whom He made in His image & likeness (**Matthew 6:26**). If we will accept God, then we will have peace within that cannot be explained. We will have assurance of the presence & power of God in our lives. God's power will guide our every move. God's arm will give strength for every task. God's potency will provide protection from every evil. We will have happiness & joy that can come from no other source. We will have a home in heaven where Christ Jesus shall be our constant companion.

All this hinges upon one thing – It comes through Jesus Christ. God offers the gift, the question is: Will we receive it? Accept this gift & we will sing **Psalms 104:34 "My meditation of him shall be sweet: I will be glad in the Lord."**
