At Calvary

Luke 23:33 – "And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified him, & the malefactors, one on the right hand, & the other on the left."

Let us take a moment & look at Calvary.

- CALVARY The place where the Son of God died that the sons of men might live (John 11:49-52 & Luke 23:46).
- CALVARY The place where the innocent blood of Jesus was shed to cleanse us all (Luke 23:41 & 1 John 1:7).
- CALVARY The place where all the sin of the world was laid on One who knew no sin (2 Corinthians 5:21).
- CALVARY The place where men can come with their troubles & find the peace which passeth all understanding (Matthew 11:28-30 & Philippians 4:7).
- CALVARY The place where you & I can receive life, joy, & assurance (1 Corinthians 1:18 & Hebrews 12:2).
- CALVARY The place where Jesus paid it all (**Acts 20:28** & **1 Corinthians 6:20**).

At Calvary, We See The Love & Compassion Of Jesus (Luke 23:34)

Jesus said, "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." Who was our Savior praying for? He was praying for those who crucified Him; those who mocked Him; those who tempted Him; those who were indifferent; those who denied Him; those who rejected Him. Jesus prayed for their salvation & God answered this prayer in Acts 2:36-41.

<u>At Calvary, We See The Perfect Picture Of Salvation (Luke 23:40-43)</u>

The thief had nothing to offer the Lord. Many in the denominational world like to use this passage in an effort to hide behind the thief & suggest baptism is not essential to salvation, for all we have to do is believe. Nevertheless, this Scripture does not teach this at all, for baptism was not a commanded until after the thief was dead (Matthew 28:19 & Mark 16:16). What we see in these Scriptures is a Savior who will save us IF we trust Him completely.

<u>At Calvary, We Hear The Promise To All Who Come To</u> Jesus (Luke 23:43)

Paradise is the resting place of the righteous after we die. Paradise is not Heaven, but it is the place where the righteous wait for Jesus to come again before the judgment (**Luke 16:19-31** – Abraham's bosom). Are we living our lives in such a way that if death were to come knocking at our door, we will hear Jesus say, "Today, you will be in Paradise?"

At Calvary, We Hear The Conclusion (John 19:30)

Salvation is within reach of all people. At Calvary, Jesus paid the penalty for our sins. It is up to us to accept His gift through obedience to His gospel (**Romans 6:23**). Let us trust Him to deliver us from the power of sin presently, so we can be delivered from the presence of sin in the future.
