# **Obedience: The Difference Between Wisdom & Foolishness**

**Scriptural Text: Matthew 25:1-13** 

This parable about the wise & foolish virgins stresses the importance of being ready for the coming of Christ. The Bible teaches us in **John 14:1-6** Jesus will come again. For this reason, He wants His people to be awake & alert. Satan seeks to put God's people to sleep spiritually, so they will not be ready. Jesus said in **Matthew 7:24-27** the foolish person is the one who is a hearer only, but a wise person is a hearer & doer. Below is an outline of a few points from this parable.

### The People (Matthew 25:1-5)

<u>The Story (Matthew 25:1)</u>. This parable teaches us the importance of readiness.

The Symbols (Matthew 25:2-4). Symbol #1 is the foolish virgins. They took no extra oil, thinking that they had plenty (Revelation 3:17). Symbol #2 is the wise virgins. They were prepared with an extra supply of oil. They did not depend upon past resources.

<u>The Sleeping (Matthew 25:5)</u>. While waiting for the wedding, they all slept. The wise went to sleep prepared, the foolish unprepared (**Proverbs 27:1**).

#### The Plan (Matthew 25:6-9)

<u>The Preparation (Matthew 25:6-7)</u>. They trimmed their lamps. We, as Christians, must trim our spiritual lives in readiness for His coming.

The Pleading (Matthew 25:8). The foolish asked the wise to give them some of their oil. They were dependent on others

for entrance to the wedding feast. Each person must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ in order to be saved.

<u>The Personal (Matthew 25:9)</u>. The wise told the foolish to go & buy oil for themselves. No one can accept Christ for us. Everybody must be born again (**John 3:1-8**).

#### The Problem (Matthew 25:10-12)

<u>The Problem (Matthew 25:10-12)</u>. God gave the people in Noah's day time to prepare (**Genesis 6:3**). Someday, the door will be closed (**Proverbs 29:1** & **Isaiah 55:6**).

The Plea (Matthew 25:11). The wise could not open the door. Only Christ can open the door (John 14:6).

<u>The Punishment (Matthew 25:12)</u>. Only those who are born again will gain entrance (John 3:1-8 & Mark 16:16).

#### The Preparation (Matthew 25:13)

How do we prepare? We prepare by watching!

Let Us Watch Our Character (**1 Corinthians 7:1**). Daily, we are developing habits, whether good or bad. It takes a lifetime to build good Christian character.

Let Us Watch Our Consecration (Romans 12:1-2). Caleb, though 85 years old, could say he had fully followed the Lord (**Deuteronomy 1:36**). God wants full surrender, full dedication.

<u>Let Us Watch Our Companions (2 Corinthians 6:17)</u>. We are known by our associations. Choose Christian friends (**Amos 3:3**).

Are we awake? Do we have enough oil? Do not depend on past experiences or blessings. Each day, let renew the touch of God upon our lives. Let us learn to walk in the Spirit, pray in the Spirit, & live in the Spirit. As the Holy Spirit influences our lives, we will be ready when the bridegroom comes.
