The Roman Road Of Salvation

Scriptural Text: Romans 1:16

What Is The Gospel?

The Gospel is Good News. It is God's message to humanity about the life & sacrificial death of Jesus Christ & how it brings salvation to all who believe & obey it. This is the reason why the Christian should speak with Paul, not only the message, but also his proclamation that he is not ashamed on Christ & His gospel.

Why Are We Not To Be Ashamed Of The Gospel Of Christ?

We are not to be ashamed of this message because, 1) It is good news & not bad news, 2) God has invested His power in this message, & 3) This message brings about salvation to all who hear, believe, & obey it.

What Is Salvation & Why Do We Need It?

Salvation is safety. Salvation is deliverance from evil. Salvation is eternal life. These are all products of obedience to the gospel of Christ. Through God's power, He provides safety to the Christian. Through God's strength, He provides deliverance from evil to the Christian. Through God's omnipotence, He provides eternal life to the Christian. Why do we need safety, deliverance, & eternal life? We need these things because the gospel teaches us we are sinners. Listen to your Bible! In **Romans 3:23**, the Bible reads, "**For all have sinned, & come short of the glory of God**." Sin is not a good thing, but a bad thing, for it brings forth death. Listen to your Bible! In **Romans 6:23**, the Bible reads, "**For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord**." One of the ways we sin is by lacking faith. Listen to your Bible! In **Romans 14:23b**, the Bible reads, "**For whatsoever is not of faith is sin**." The Gospel is our road map as we travel this road to salvation. It is through the gospel message, we learn we are sinners. Listen to your Bible! In Romans 5:19, the Bible reads, "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous." It is through the gospel message; we learn what Jesus did for us in order to save us. Listen to your Bible! In Romans 5:6-8, the Bible reads, "For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." It is through the gospel message, we learn God did not call us to be sinners, but He has called us to be saints. Listen to your Bible! In Romans 1:7a, the Bible reads, "To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to **be saints**." Since a lack of faith is a problem, the gospel teaches us how to receive this faith. Listen to your Bible! In **Romans 10:17**, the Bible reads, "So then faith cometh by hearing, & hearing by the word of God."

We have faith when we believe & confess Christ. Listen to your Bible! In Romans 10:9-10, the Bible reads, "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, & shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; & with the mouth confession is made unto We have faith when we repent of our sins salvation." understanding it was the goodness of God, which brought us to this point (Romans 2:4). We have faith when we are baptized into Christ. Listen to your Bible! In Romans 6:3-4, the Bible reads, "Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life." It is only in Christ, we have redemption (Romans 3:24). It is only in Christ, there is not condemnation (Romans 8:1). It is only in Christ, we reap the benefits of God's love (Romans 8:38-39). It is only in Christ, we can be one body; one church (**Romans 12:5**).
