Jesus' obedience to the authority of the Father resulted in His being exalted to the highest place.

I Corinthians 15:20-28

Jesus' authority from God is so absolute that it even includes authority over death itself.



I Corinthians 15:20-28

The only being in all existence not under Jesus' rule is the authorizing Father Himself.



The enemies of Jesus threatened His authorized disciples and commanded them to disobey.



The apostles were forced to make a distinction regarding which authority took precedence.



The apostles prayed to God for a clarification of authority so that they might obey boldly.



Obedience to God was choosing to side with the higher authority without fostering rebellion.





God's demonstration of power was an encouragement to His servants following His commands.



Using physical pressure to stop the spread of the gospel, the leaders persecuted the apostles.



The apostles not only acted within the superior authority of Christ, they preached it to others.



Obedience to God was the fundamental message that the apostles preached and modeled.
