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쳐 Genesis 4:9 — "And the Lord said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: 🔁 am I my brother's keeper?"

Yes, we are our brother's keeper. So, who are we to keep & what does this involve?

<u> ★ Who Is My Brother?</u>

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★When I say, "my brother," this is also inclusive of "my sisters" as well. My brother is a person who has the same spiritual kinship & like precious faith as I do. Listen to your Bible! In 2 Peter 1:1, the Bible reads, "Simon Peter, ightharpoons a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Savior Jesus Christ." In John 8:44, the Bible reads, lpha Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the lpha beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it." My brother is a person who does the will of God, according to Matthew 12:46-50. My brother is a person who is saved & believes the truth. In 2 Thessalonians 2:13, the Bible reads, "But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth."

<u>☆ What Is Involved In Being My Brother's Keeper?</u>

In **Exodus 2:11-12**, the Bible reads, "**And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was** 🛪 grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian lpha smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren. $\,$ And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the Egyptian, and hid him in the sand." As my brother's keeper, I am to help him during his time of adversity. Listen to your Bible! In **Proverbs 17:17**, the Bible reads, "**A friend loveth at** all times, and a brother is born for adversity." As my brother's keeper, I am to stick close to him. In Proverbs 18:24, the Bible reads, "A man that hath friends must shew himself friendly: and there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother." As my brother's keeper, I am to believe in him & have confidence in him. Listen to your Bible! In **John 7:5**, the Bible reads, "**For neither did his brethren believe in him**." Also, in 1 Corinthians 13:7, the Bible reads, "Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things."
