When Worship Is Wrong



Scriptural Text: Malachi 1:6-14

Worship Is Wrong When God Himself Has To Question What We Are Doing

Where is my honor? (*Malachi 1:6*) * Where is my fear? (*Malachi 1:6*) * If you offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil (*Malachi 1:8*)

* Offer it now to your governor, will he be pleased with you or accept your person? (*Malachi 1:8*) * Who is there even among you that would shut the doors for nought? (*Malachi 1:10*) * Should I accept this of your hand? (*Malachi 1:13*) – If God is asking these questions due to our worship to Him, then there is definitely something wrong with our praise.

<u>Man Questioning God Does Not Make Our Worship To</u> <u>Him Right</u>

Wherein have we polluted You? (*Malachi 1:7*) * Wherein have we despised Your name? (*Malachi 1:6*) – If God questions us, then this does not give us the right to question God. Instead of challenging God, man must challenge himself & diligently seek God's will in matters of worship.

Worship Is Wrong When God Makes Accusations Against The Worshipper

Priests have despised My name (*Malachi 1:6*) * Priests offer polluted bread upon My altar (*Malachi 1:7*) * Priests do not kindle fire on My altar for nothing (*Malachi 1:10*) * Priests have profaned My name (*Malachi 1:12*) * Priests have snuffed at My name (*Malachi 1:13*) * Priests have brought an offering that was torn, lame, & sick (*Malachi 1:13*) – Whether we agree with God on this subject of worship or not, one thing is always true: God cannot lie (*Titus 1:2*). Therefore, if He says we have violated His law or acting without authority, then we must repent & submit to the will of the Almighty or prepare to face the consequences for disobedience.

Worship Is Wrong When We Criticize God's Way

The table of the Lord is contemptible (*Malachi 1:7*) * The table of the Lord is polluted & the fruit thereof, even His meat, is contemptible (*Malachi 1:12*) * What a weariness it is (*Malachi 1:13*) – God's way is always the best way. Unfortunately, we are living in an age where man is dissatisfied with God's way. When God is silent, man makes a habit of speaking & doing. Sounds familiar??? (*Jeremiah 23:21*). The world, & even some Christians, criticize "book, chapter, & verse" preaching, acappella music, simplistic worship, & the spiritual work of the church. However, this is God's way & if we want to make Heaven our home, then our way must become His way (*Proverbs 10:29*).

<u>Worship Is Wrong When God Passes Judgment Not In</u> <u>Our Favor</u>

I have no pleasure in you (*Malachi 1:10*) * I will not accept an offering by your hand (*Malachi 1:10*) * My name will be made great among the Gentiles (*Malachi 1:11*) * Cursed be the deceiver because I am a great King (*Malachi 1:14*) – Just because we worship God in a way we think is best, does not mean God has & will accept it. Anytime we do things our way, God will have no pleasure in it, He will not accept it, & we will be cursed instead of blessed because of our non-performance to His will (*Proverbs 14:12*).

This was a major issue in Malachi's day. So, God sent this messenger to preach to the people. The purpose was to prepare the Israelites for the coming of the Christ. As Christians, we learn from this prophet's message the very things we must get right with God now, so we can be prepared for the second coming of the Lord. The solution to making worship right was given in *Malachi 1:9* & it is very much relevant today..."*Turning to God is the only hope humanity has.*"
