

What's Your Priority?



Matthew 6:33 — "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; & all these things shall be added unto you."

Whatever our priority is, then this is what we put first. If our priorities are mixed up, then our values are confused. Jesus said in

Matthew 6:33, "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, & his righteousness; & all these things shall be added unto you." Many individuals have problems in their lives because their priority is not the kingdom of God, nor is it the righteousness of God, but rather all these things. Things have become our priority & if things have become our priority, then let it be understood; our values are confused. Nothing comes before first. The only thing that comes before first is a big, fat zero with the edges cut off, which is simply nothing. We are beginning to put things before God, His kingdom, & His righteousness. The reason for this is because we do not have the proper understanding for the supreme demand of proper priorities.

The Bible teaches that we must seek first the kingdom of God. Where there is a kingdom, there is a king. The king is supreme in his kingdom. The king is first in his kingdom. The king is #1 in his kingdom. Nobody comes before the king. In the kingdom of God, God is the King. God is supreme, first, & #1 in His kingdom. Therefore, we must put God first in our lives. We have to make Him the priority. Question: Is God first in your life? I'm not asking if God is a resident in your life, but I am asking is God the President in your life. I'm not asking if God has a piece in your life; if God has a place in your life; or if God has a part in your life; I'm asking is God the priority in your life. If not, then "what's your priority?" God has to be the supreme ruler in our lives. We have to stop looking for

something & start looking for someone. We know what God can do & we know who God is. Therefore, we want what God has & we want what God provides, but are we spending time with the King?

Why must I put God first? Besides Jesus commanding this of us, there are some essential benefits, which can only be accomplished by putting Him first. Listen to your Bible! In Psalms 23:1, the Bible reads, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want." The same Psalmist said in Psalms 37:25, "I have been young, & now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread." Paul re-emphasizes this Biblical fact in Philippians 4:19, where the Bible reads, "But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus." When we put God first, then He will be our Shepherd. He will lead us into the pathways of righteousness. He will never forsake us or allow our children to go hungry. He will supply all, not some, but all of our needs. When we put God first, then there isn't anything we want because in God, we have all we need! Let us never make the mistake of making some person our priority. Do the right thing & make God the priority.

What's your priority? Is it God, His kingdom, & His righteousness? If not, then what's your priority? Who or what is more important than God? Did you know God can do anything, but fail? Why not make a proven, sovereign, & benevolent God your priority today? How can a person forget the Creator of the universe & the Sustainer of their life? How can a person portray God as a loser or even second best? God has been better to us than we could ever be to ourselves & He deserves to be #1, first, & the priority of our lives? Make God your priority today before it is eternally & everlasting too late.
